




VIRTUAL SUNDAY SCHOOL

We will be using the series Book by Book for a 6-week study on the book of Phillipians. Each session will include a 15 minute video with discussion afterwards. Joni Eareckson Tada, a quadriplegic since 1967, is founder of Joni and Friends, a ministry that communicates the Gospel and equips churches worldwide to evangelize people affected by disability. Richard Bewes is a rector of All Souls Church, Langham Place, London and a well-known writer and broadcaster. Paul Blackham from Lancashire, England, is a theologian and curate at All Souls Church in London.
