Message: “New Year, Fresh Start: God’s Word”

Scripture: Psalm 1

January 17, 2021

Questions to Consider:

- When you went on a road trip with your family, what kept you entertained? Was it singing songs or playing car games? Did you read, sleep or just keep entertained by watching the scenery?
- Read Psalm 1. What observations do you make? What descriptive images are used? What type of poetic devices are used in this poem? What is compared and contrasted in the poem?
- Are there “sinners” that you walk with? Is this a good or bad thing for your spiritual life? Are there some relationships that you should be wary? What can you do to make sure these relationships don’t “lead you to a path of destruction?”
- How are you “velcroed” to God’s Word and God’s people? How might you “delight” in the law of the Lord? What do you do (or might you do) to “meditate” on God’s Word and to be connected with God’s people?
- What steps can you take this week to be a person that delights in God’s Word and is connected to His people? Who can hold you accountable to these steps?

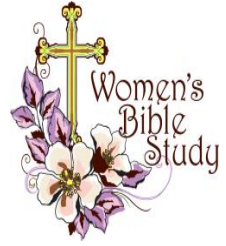
