Questions to Consider:

- Who taught you to write thank you notes?
- Read Acts 16:11-40 to understand the background to which Paul is writing to Philippi. What do you notice from Luke’s account in Acts?
- Read Philippians 1:1-11. What feelings does Paul have for the Philippians?
- What is the “good work” which will be completed when the Lord returns? What does this imply for your future?
- Who was (or is) a “Paul” in your life who encouraged you to grow in your faith? How did they encourage you?
- Who might you talk with (or write an email, send a text or write a letter) to encourage them in their faith? Pray for that person now and for the words that you will use to encourage their faith.
