A WORD FROM PASTOR TIM

Two Invitations: The 130th Anniversary Celebration & Holy Week Services

I have two invitations for you to consider in the upcoming weeks.

The first invitation is for the 130th anniversary of Lakeside Community Presbyterian Church at the historic old church on Maine Street on Sunday, March 19. I hope that you will make plans to be at this celebration as we remember God's faithfulness to His church, as we celebrate the impact that this church has had in the Lakeside Community over the years and as we pray for His calling for our impact on lives in the years to come.

Come hungry and invite your friends as we will have a yummy pancake breakfast following the service.

The second invitation is for you to take some time during the Season of Lent to prepare for Holy Week (April 2-7) and Easter (on April 9).

In the ancient church, Lent was a time for new converts to be instructed for baptism and for believers to focus on repentance. In time, all Christians came to see Lent as a season to be reminded of their need for penitence and to prepare spiritually for the celebration of Easter. Part of this preparation involved the Lenten "fast," giving up something special during the six weeks of Lent.

During Lent you may have taken time to do something special, to go deeper, in your spiritual walk. You may have gone on a "fast," giving up something as a spiritual discipline like meat, chocolate or caffeine (the Catholic

tradition has followed the giving up of meat on the Fridays of Lent – which is why you may know people who refrain from eating red meats and instead, eat fish on Fridays). It could also be the addition of a spiritual discipline, like reading a chapter in the Gospels, praying at a certain time each day or being a part of a Growth Group.

When we approach the final week of Lent (also known as Holy Week), I want to encourage you take some time to prepare your heart for Easter. Look for opportunities that may draw your closer to Christ, remembering His final week as He walked to the cross. Attend our Palm Sunday Service (April 2) as we process into church celebrating Christ as the Messiah. Throughout Holy Week, you can attend a mid-day communion service during Holy Week (we will have a service every day at 12pm), come to our Maundy Thursday service, or the Good Friday service. Each of these services in some deeper and dramatic way offer another glimpse into the life of Christ and what He did on the cross for us. It also allows us to experience Easter in a new and deeper way.

There are a lot of good things that are happening at LCPC in the coming weeks and I hope that you will accept the invitation to be a part.

In the month of March, several food programs that increased food stamps during 2020-2023 (due to Covid), received additional food stamps. However some of these programs are coming to an end, while at the same time, food prices are rising considerably.
