

What is Box Top\$ for Education? It is an easy fundraiser for schools, including our Children's Center and the best part it doesn't cost you anything extra!

Box Top\$ for Education is an easy way for our Children's Center to earn cash and LCPC will make it even easier for you. First: No Clipping! If you do not own a smart phone, or don't want to download the APP, just drop off your grocery receipt to the office and we will submit (scan) the full grocery receipt on your behalf so that our Children's Center will earn cash for various needs. We can submit up to 50 grocery receipts per day but it must be within 14 days of the date of purchased as indicated on the receipt. Items that have the Box Top\$ symbol are validated by Box Top\$ from the receipt and the school will receive a check 2x a year (December & April).

You can also download the Box Top\$ App on your smart phone and be sure to select Lakeside Presbyterian Children's Center. After your grocery shopping trip or online shopping just take a photo of the receipt using the Box Top\$ App. You will be immediately notified if you purchased Box Top\$ items and the amount earned for the Children's Center.

So keep buying your groceries and turn in your receipt to the office: it's that easy and the Children's Center will benefit.

SEE WHAT'S IN OUR LIBRARY!

The Minor Prophets offer major lessons for all ages, and their timeless truths have been highlighted and enjoyed through Pastor Tim's sermon series on the "Minor Prophets." If you would like your children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews to know more about the minor prophets, they are now shared in story book form for each of the minor prophets, as part of a series: **God's Daring Dozen**. These books have been shared with our Sunday school students and deliver messages that are very relevant, today. They are "biblically faithful, theologically rich, gospel-centered books that teach truth and inspire faith in God and in His Son." You may remember that Pastor Tim even used the book on Obadiah, as part of a recent Sunday sermon.

The sets include:

- Haggai's Feast, which teaches obedience and encourages courage
- Habakkuk's Song, which teaches trust and deepens faith
- Zephaniah's Hero, which teaches repentance and promotes righteousness
- Obadiah & the Edomites, which teaches humility and offers hope
- Other sets include Hosea, Joel, Amos, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Zechariah, and Malachi. (We have set 1 and 2 in the library. Set 3 has yet to be released.)


SCRIP SALES HELP OUR PRESCHOOL AND LCPC WITH ONGOING PROJECTS

Community Service

Serving our community is another way that we make a difference for God's Kingdom here in Lakeside. There are a variety of opportunities, some on a regular basis (i.e. Lakeside HELPS Center) and others on a one-time basis. The church office has a list of activities where we serve. (*See the opportunities to serve in our community on the attached list below)

SCRIP Gift Cards

LCPC offers Scrip gift cards to over 100 retailers like restaurants (Panera Bread, Starbucks, Olive Garden and many more), fast-food eateries, grocery stores (Sprouts, Albertsons, Vons), gas stations, Office Depot, Home Depot, Amazon, Michaels, Nordstrom, and many, many more. Rebates to the church range from 3–12% depending on the retailer and are used to fund ministries here at LCPC. Contact the church office for details of participating retailers and how you can purchase Scrip gift cards.

Recyclable Bottles and Cans

We collect recyclable bottles and cans for cash and use these funds for LCPC ministries.

Retirement Plan Contributions

If you are 70 ½ or older, you can make Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) as a gift without incurring taxes.*

Stocks, Bonds and Mutual Funds

If you directly transfer your appreciated stock to LCPC instead of selling these first, you will not pay any capital gains tax and you may be entitled to a tax deduction.*

Endowment Funds

Create a memorial or legacy gift that will provide a source of support to our church in perpetuity.*
*Consult with your tax advisor to determine your estimated personal tax benefits and/or our church's treasurer.

WAYS TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

There are a variety of ways that you can make a difference in the mission of our church. Your various contributions help us to live out that mission:

Below are a variety of ways that you can help live this mission in our world:

Use your Gifts and Talents in Ministries at LCPC

As a family of faith, your gifts and talents are essential for LCPC to function. We are not the church without you. As each of us use our gifts, we are able to be God's Kingdom people here in Lakeside, East County and beyond. Your spiritual gifts will help us to be the church and to grow the church. Your talents and skills will help us to function as a church family. We need one another to be the Body of Christ.

Serve on a Committee or as a Deacon

Our church structure functions through the service of two elected offices: **Elders and Deacons**. These are the official ways that we function and run the church. Anyone may volunteer to serve on a committee (You don't have to be a member to serve on a committee but you do have to be an **Elder** to chair the committee). The standing committees at LCPC are: <u>Spiritual Life</u> (that oversees the worship and outreach), <u>Discipleship and Missions</u> (that oversees education and our mission outreach), <u>Personnel and Preschool Board</u> (that oversees the personnel of the church and serve as the Board of the Preschool), and <u>Stewardship and Property</u> (that oversees the finances of the church and the maintenance of the church buildings and grounds). The **Deacons** function as a separate body and serve the church by giving oversight to the various ministries of care by our church.
