Well, let me encourage you to try again this year to read the entire Bible but this time, do it with others at LCPC, as together, we read the 66 books of the Bible in 2026.

We are going to follow the one-year guide provided by The Bible Recap. You can read the Bible daily following the plan or you can listen to the Bible on your phone or computer by connecting to the Bible Recap website (www.thebible Recap.com). We will print out the weekly Bible readings passages and we will also offer some small groups (in person and on-line) to help encourage one another to read the entire Bible in 2026.

The thing I like about the Bible Recap is that after each reading there is a summary of what was read by the host, Tara-Leigh Cobble. She does a good job of giving a

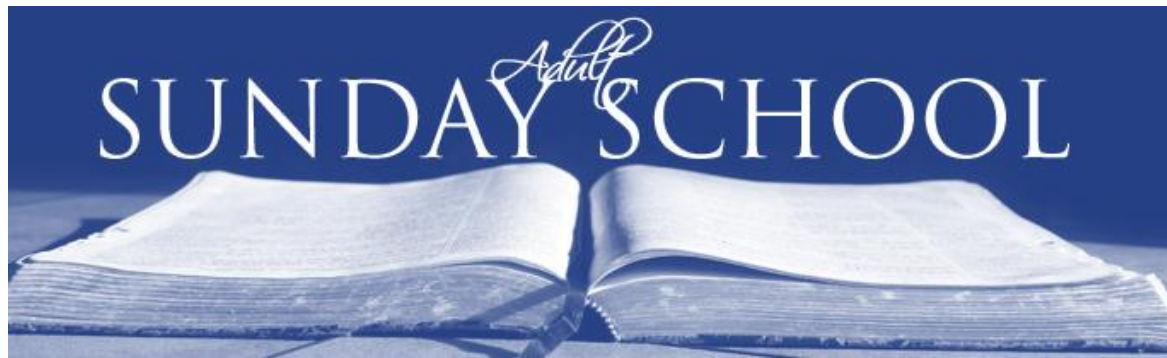

LAKESIDE CHRISTIAN HELPS CENTER

THE CHOSEN – SEASON 5

The Chosen, (if you don't know) is a television series that depicts the life of Jesus. Each television show reveals a different part of Jesus' story, especially as seen through the eyes of His followers. Each Wednesday, after viewing the episode we will follow with some Q & A so that questions can be asked and we can learn more about Jesus.

The Prayer Quilt group has had a productive couple of months. On October 19th we had our annual sale which was very successful! On November 24th we gathered to pack 50 Thanksgiving meals for the military. Thanks to donations from the Optimists Club in Lakeside and our congregation this was once again a successful event. Then on December 9th we hosted the Christmas shopping event for the MOMs (Military Outreach). Sioux again provided horse driven wagon rides for this event. All of these events were successful only because members of our congregation supported them with their participation!

We have now administered 842 Prayer Quilt dedications. Are you aware that on the back of each of our Prayer Quilts there is a cross? Also, on the back of each quilt there is a personalized label for the recipient which includes their name, date of dedication and an appropriate bible verse. We want to extend our thanks to the members of the congregation for their time to say a prayer for each quilt recipient as they tie a square knot. Please do stop to tie a knot and say a prayer for the recipient, even if you do not know that person. All ties must have a square knot before we give the quilt away to prevent the ties from coming out. Your taking a few minutes to stop at the quilts, say a prayer and tie a knot demonstrates your support for this program! We have received many expressions of gratitude for the quilts and frequent validation of the power of the prayers tied into the quilt.

The Prayer Quilt group is dedicated to our mission and has become a close-knit group of friends. Our group has now grown to 22 members, with only 3 of us “original” members.
